





Under the direction of Dr. Anthony Offerle, the UF Opera Theatre's staging of Paul Richard's, The Golem of Prague, was a 2023 winner of the National Opera Association award for large scale opera production.

From the General Director



When I arrived at First Coast Opera in 2014, Saint Augustine was preparing to celebrate the 450th Anniversary of its founding with many Spanishthemed events. The FCO Board asked me to produce either *Don Giovanni* or *Carmen*, neither in Spanish nor written by Spaniards, but, of course, both with well-known Spanish settings and stories. That year, we performed Mozart's *Don Giovanni*.

Back then, I didn't think we were ready to tackle the much-bigger *Carmen*, and it has remained at the top of our wish list. Eleven years later, it is finally time! Our upcoming *Carmen* will be the company's largest to date, with more than 80 people creating it, including a cast of 40 and orchestra of 22. I hope you will attend one of our three performances.

FCO has performed more Gilbert and Sullivan operettas than works by any other composer, with *The Mikado* last done here in 2006. It is a brilliant comedy with creative characters and tuneful music. Set in the fictional Japanese town of Titipu, the work satirizes British government of the late 19th Century. We now sit in the 21st Century and governments remain popular fodder for comedians. Don't miss this traditional toe-tapping favorite!

I am very pleased to welcome, this evening, members of the Opera Department at the University of Florida. Providing opportunities for local and regional talent has always been part of FCO's mission. Talented young performers prove that opera and singing remain vital and inspiring art forms. Thank you for attending *Fanfare!* and supporting First Coast Opera.




