St. Augustine baritone **Dirk Gavin McCoy** is a frequent performer with First Coast Opera. In additional to multiple FCO concerts, he has appeared as Marcello in Pasta & Puccini/*La Boheme;* Sergeant Miller in the 2018 FL premiere of Curtis Tucker's *The Stranger's Tale* (with subsequent reprisal this past week); King Melchior in *Amahl and the Night Visitors* and Uncle Bonzo in *Madama Butterfly.* Dirk recently sang the role of David in

Samuel Barber's *A Hand of Bridge* for Jacksonville-based Bold City Opera's inaugural production. He sang the title role of *Gianni Schicchi* and the 3rd Trio Member in *Trouble in Tahiti* with the Mid-Ohio Civic Opera Company, having previously sung the role for the 2022 Romanza Festivale. Dirk has sung in the prestigious choruses of the New York City Opera and Washington National Opera, singing or covering comprimario roles in both houses.

Caitlin McKechney is thrilled to be making her First Coast Opera debut! Recent performances include Bradamante in Alcina with St. Petersburg Opera; the title role in Carmen with Painted Sky Opera, Opera Memphis and Tacoma Opera; Virginia Woolf in the staged production of Argento's From the Diary of Virginia Woolf; and Woman 4 in the world premiere of Letters That You Will Not



Get with The American Opera Project, for which she also served as Associate Producer. Upcoming performances include The Opera Cowgirls performance with Pensacola Opera as well as her final DMA recital at SUNY Stony Brook, after which you may call her "Dr. McKechney."

**Jacob Pence** is excited to make his First Coast Opera debut in *Copland's America*. Recent performances include Sam in Curtis Tucker's *The Stranger's Tale;* Opera Orlando's *Daughter of the Regiment;* Jeff in *OutLoud*! with Opera Tampa; Ben Weatherstaff in *The Secret Garden* with Central Florida Vocal Arts; Simone in *Gianni Schicchi* with Opera Orlando; and Boy Capel in the première of Nathan Felix's new Opera, *No.*

auf Naxos, Tom Rakewell in The Rake's Progress, Normanno in Lucia di Lammermoor and Alfredo in La Traviata. Aaron also enjoys performing concert works. He was privileged to appear as the soloist in Joseph Julian Gonzalez's work Misa Azteca and as the tenor soloist cover in Verdi's Requiem under Kieth Lockhart. When not singing, Aaron performs as an improv violinist and studio musician.



Soprano **Megan Warburton** is pleased to make her First Coast Opera debut. She recently performed as Kay in Curtis Tucker's *The Strangers Tale*; sang with the Wichita Falls Symphony Orchestra as the soprano soloist in *Carmina Burana* and as Sophie in *Werther* with the University of Michigan. She is a graduate of the University of Michigan's Master of Music program and teaches at the College of Charleston.



**Curtis Tucker** celebrates his tenth season as General and Artistic Director with First Coast Opera. During his tenure, the company has expanded its performances and budget and been recognized as a Professional Company Member of Opera America. This season he directs *Copland's America*, conducts *La Bohème*, and sings Major General Stanley in *The Pirates of Penzance*. Elsewhere, he has led concerts and

productions for Cincinnati Opera, Opera Memphis, Opera Saratoga, Syracuse Opera, Mobile Opera, University of Mobile, and the University of North Florida. His original family opera, *The Trial of B. B. Wolf*, was performed at the annual conference of the National Opera Association, and his opera *The Stranger's Tale* recently received a performance grant from United Arts of Central Florida.

A sought-after collaborative pianist and organist of unique versatility, **Michael Giuliani** graduated from North Park University in Chicago, IL with a degree in piano, and went on to pursue a Master's degree in organ at Concordia University Chicago. He has held positions with Charleston Southern University, North Central College, Tim Zimmerman & The King's Brass, the Charleston Symphony Orchestra Gospel & Spiritual



ensembles, and the acclaimed St. Charles Singers, among others. Primarily a church musician, Michael is currently the Director of Music & Organist at Trinity Parish in beautiful downtown St. Augustine.



**Deborah Smith** has been a professional actor for over 30 years performing locally in such shows as *Showboat, Christmas Carole, King and I,* and *Lend Me a Tenor*, to name a few. Deborah has also worked both backstage in makeup and hair for the First Coast Opera as well as costumed several operas including *Amahl and the Night Visitors, La Boheme, Cox and Box/ Penelope's Revenge, Le Doctor Miracle* and *Bon Appetit*. 


